

POSITION

1. General provisions

1) In order to attract young scientists to solving issues of science and technology development, the development of the scientific potential of the republic, to increase the effectiveness of solving problems of young scientists and to attract young people themselves to their solution, permanent councils of young scientists are being created in scientific organizations and higher educational institutions.

2) Young scientists are recognized as researchers, interns, researchers, undergraduates and doctoral students, university teachers engaged in scientific activities under the age of 35.

3) The Council of Young Scientists of the D. Serikbayev NAO EKTU is the main link in the system of the Council of scientific youth.

4) The Council is a public body under the leadership of a scientific organization, a higher educational institution.

5) Responsibility for the creation of the Council in the NAO of the D. Serikbayev EKTU and the coordination of its activities is assigned to the head.

6) The main tasks of the Council are:

1) promoting the professional growth of scientific youth, their active participation in fundamental and applied research;

2) performing the role of a representative body and protecting the rights of scientific youth in the academic council and the leadership of the organization, as well as in state bodies and public organizations, expressing the views of scientific youth on various aspects of professional activity and social and living conditions;

3) initiating the creation of youth research and innovation centers on a self-supporting basis, as well as other forms of organizing research activities;

4) combining the efforts of young scientists to solve urgent scientific problems and priority scientific tasks;

5) activation of research work of young scientists through a system of specially designed events;

6) improving the forms of participation of young scientists in research projects, research grants, competitions, programs, internships;

7) formation and expansion of a network of contacts with the Councils of other scientific organizations, higher educational institutions.

2. Functions of the Council

The Council performs the following functions:

1) organization of conferences, seminars and meetings of young scientists, lecture cycles of leading scientists, assistance and support for the participation of young scientists in national and international conferences and seminars, symposiums, internships;

2) organization of information support for young scientists on foundations, grants, conferences, competitions and other events in the Republic of Kazakhstan,

countries of the near and far abroad, on measures of state support for young scientific personnel in the Republic of Kazakhstan;

3) collection and systematization of information about domestic and foreign funds and programs that provide grant support to young scientists;

4) contributing to the publications of young scientists by providing methodological and organizational support;

5) organization of joint research projects of young scientists of Kazakhstan, foreign higher educational institutions and research centers;

6) promotion of access to the use of expensive equipment by youth teams, organization of training in modern methods of work on the latest equipment;

7) creation of a database of young scientists who have gone abroad. Establishing contacts with them in order to carry out joint work, as well as attracting them to work in Kazakhstan;

8) search for forms of solving housing and other social problems of young people working in scientific organizations and higher educational institutions;

9) preparation and holding of sports and cultural events.

3. Council rights

In order to perform its functions, the Council has the right:

1) prepare proposals on all issues related to the work of the Council to improve the material and technical security of the scientific activities of young scientists;

2) participate in the preparation and examination of documents and regulatory legal acts related to the problems of scientific youth;

3) to make proposals for the support and encouragement of individual young scientists for their achievements;

4) provide candidates for young scientists to participate in scientific conferences, seminars, symposiums and other events;

5) to organize sports and recreation and cultural and leisure activities with the participation of young scientists.

4. Responsibility and authority

The Council consists of young scientists of D. Serikbayev EKTU, participating in it on the principle of voluntariness. The Chairman organizes the activities of the council and represents the interests of young scientists of the university.

The Chairman of the Council may be elected from among the scientific staff, not older than 35 years at the time of election, for a period of up to three years by secret or open voting (by decision of the majority of those present) by a simple majority of the list of young scientists.

The Chairman of the Council is a member of the Academic Council of the University, respectively.

The Council carries out its activities on the basis of an annual work plan. Based on the results for the year, the Council prepares a report and reports it at the general meeting of the Council.
